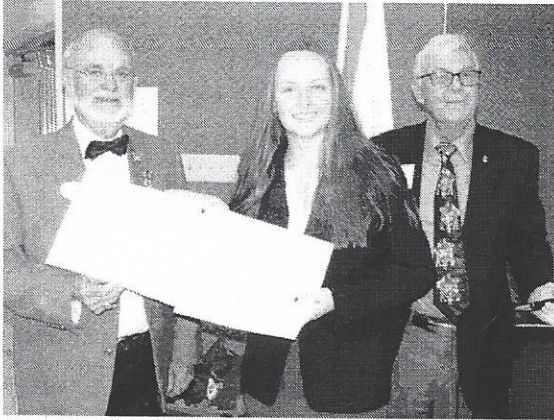

The Lago Vista Leo's provided breakfast at the Ronald McDonald House for families of critically ill children undergoing medical treatment at Dell Children's hospital.

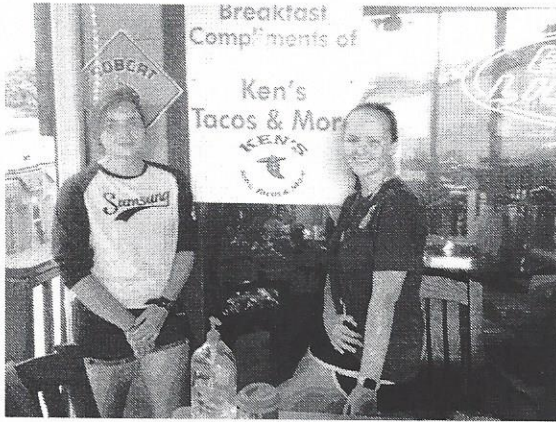
