KidSight Update

The Lions Clubs are known the world over for our dedication to issues of sight, and arguably, one of the most important tasks we undertake in this mission is to screen young students for developing eyesight conditions. Caught in time many youngsters can avoid more serious issues as they grow older. We have screened 4,335 kids year-to-date while referring 12-15% (average) for a full exam. Had those students all gone to an optometrist for an exam at an average of \$40 per exam, that would represent over \$173,000.

For those with limited resources, we have an agreement with North Shore Eyecare for Lago Vista students in which we pay for an exam and glasses at a special negotiated price. The school nurse recommends those students and we make the arrangements.

For students outside our area, we provide an information sheet from the parent company of America's Best Contact Lenses & Eyeglasses in Lakeline Plaza for access to a philanthropic effort they are conducting.

We have one more screening on the books for December 12 which will take our total to around 4,600+. Many thanks to all who have volunteered, become certified and served, a record breaking 33 Lago Vista Lions!

Lifelong Friends, our local no kill pet shelter located in Lago Vista takes in stray and abandoned dogs and cats and is dedicated to preventing animal suffering, rescuing, and caring for stray and abandoned dogs and cats, finding good homes for these animals, and educating the public about responsible pet ownership. It's operated totally by volunteers who keep the shelter active. The volunteers do many tasks, including walking dogs, feeding the animals, administering medications, cleaning their crates, fund raising, and helping with off-site pet adoptions.

In addition to the basic costs such as food, Lifelong Friends also pays for vet care, including vaccinations, heart-worm preventative, spaying or neutering, medications, dental care, micro-chipping, and specialized vet care provided by several local veterinary clinics.

Lifelong Friends, founded in 1997, is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization. They have no funding support from government sources and depend solely on contributors, adopters, and volunteers to make sure the animals have the care they need every day until they are adopted into their forever home.
