





A highlight of our July 18th meeting was the announcement of the two new Lago Vista Lions to receive their Melvin Jones Fellowships. Lion Dale Mitchell used a backdrop of previous recipients to summarize the achievements of both Joe Wolverton and Kevin Sullivan. A distinguishing characteristic of our club is that MJF's are acquired by the Club as a means of recognizing the achievements and contributions of outstanding members.

Joe Wolverton became a Lion in 1994 in Gatesville, serving on the Board of Directors and accepting other leadership responsibilities. In 2015 Lion Joe was sponsored by PDG Paul Steinfort to become a member of the Georgetown Lions and one year later we were fortunate to welcome him to the Lago Vista Lions. After sponsoring his wife Glenda to also become a member, he chaired the Club Bar Service for SIX YEARS! In 2017 he added the responsibility of chairing the Youth Peace Poster contest, which he continues to do. But that's not all!

He has worked in various capacities for the annual golf tournament along with providing an item for the silent auction each year and being a Diamond sponsor in 2022. In 2017 he served at the Veterans Park Rededication Ceremony, in 2019 he trained on the SPOT vision screening device; served on the welcome committee at the Texas Lions Camp; served as judge for the Youth Speech Contest and again in 2020. Lion Joe Wolverton was nominated for Lion of the Quarter in 2016, 2017, and 2019.

Adjectives that best describe Lion Joe are: dedicated, trustworthy, quiet, approachable, always friendly and eager to help.



Kevin Sullivan joined Lions in June 2018 (5 years ago). He immediately began to serve his first year of membership: Pancake Breakfast, Labor Day BBQ Team, Friends Of The Library BBQ Team, the Diabetes Walk, City Christmas Tree Lighting, the Chili Feast, getting sponsors for the Golf Tournament, Texas Lions Camp Workday, and monthly Road Clean-ups. With that involvement, he was our nominee for the District Silver Spur Award for the 2018-2019 term. He has continued to willingly serve in these activities in each additional year since joining. He was elected as the Club

Marketing Chairperson for the 2019-2020 Board of Directors and served for three years continuing the use of Facebook and other social media platforms. He was also responsible for the Club's web-site and distribution of the monthly newsletter for 2019-2022. He provided live feeds of club meetings during the pandemic and coordinated Club dinners for 1Q 19-20 and was selected by membership vote as the LOQ for that quarter. The unique "ice storm" of Feb '21 brought challenges to the community and Lion Kevin served two days distributing water to citizens at City Hall followed by setting up a GoFundMe page to collect funds for needy residents. He was again selected as the LOQ for the 3Q 20-21 quarter and as the LOY for 2020-2021. He has served Lago Vista as City Councilman for 2016-2017 & 2019-2023 and was Mayor Pro-Temp 2021-2022. Responsible for Council liaison to Library Advisory Board and Economic Development Committee with increasing involvement with growth of the City. He is recognized as a willing and cheerful worker and continues to be a major contributor to the success of our Lago Vista Lions Club.



LEO Monsie Martinez Awarded Int'l LEO of the Year (2020)


