




Scholarships

One of our meaningful committees is the Scholarship Committee-particularly for the impact it has on the lives of the young adults it recognizes for their academic achievements. This year the scholarship committee welcomes two new members: Chelaine Marion and Jan Robbins have joined Sara Bush, Jerry Nilsson-Weiskott, Susan Nilsson-Weiskott, and Chairperson, Pat O'Dea Rosen. We thought our readers would enjoy learning about the myriad steps that go into selecting the students who earn the scholarships.

- 1. The High School Counselor gathers the applications. This year, Counselor Lara Clark transitioned to applications via Google Docs which was very helpful.
- 2. Committee members receive the applications, one Viking and one Lion application for each student.
- 3. Committee members review each application independently.
- 4. Committee members provisionally score each application.
- 5. The committee members then meet via Zoom to discuss shared impressions, questions, and concerns.
- 6. The committee Chair receives the conglomerate scores and based on the results, sends out invitations to the finalists to schedule Zoom interview sessions.
- 7. During the Zoom interviews committee members dialogue with the applicants to gain a deeper understanding of their commitment and motivation.



- 9. The Chair and club President attend the Blue and Gold Ceremony at the High School where the winners and their accomplishments are heralded, but no mention is made of the amount of the award.
- 10. The LV Lions Board of Directors receives a report which includes a short paragraph about each of the awardees, including their destination colleges or trade schools.

This year, a total of twenty applications were received and fourteen finalists have been notified to prepare for the Zoom interviews on April 30. We can all look forward to more information about the winners in future meetings and newsletters. For now, it is kndos to our committee members who are giving so much of their time and expertise in furthering the higher education goals of Lago Vista High School graduates.


