**Who Doesn't
Love a Puppy?**

Our April 21 program meeting had tails wagging as we welcomed the Austin Puppy Raisers, volunteers who partner with Guide Dogs for the Blind to prepare future guide dogs.

From an early age, these remarkable dogs learn behaviors that go far beyond typical pet training—responding to commands with precision (yes, even going to the bathroom on cue!) and demonstrating impressive awareness of their surroundings. By 14–16 months, they advance to “Puppy College,” in California or Oregon where they master more complex skills, including the critical concept of intelligent disobedience—the ability to ignore a command if it would put their human partner in danger.

Puppy Raisers are dedicated volunteers who meet monthly and regularly expose the dogs to real-world environments—movies, elevators, grocery stores, and other settings filled with noise and distractions—to ensure they are calm, confident, and prepared. While some expenses like food and veterinary care are reimbursed, these volunteers generously cover many additional costs themselves.

Our club is proud to support this impactful program, helping meet needs that arise along the way. And yes—we were thoroughly charmed, especially by Fiesta, the spirited black lab who kept her trainer on her toes!

Special Note:

Our treasurer, Mike Zaydel—a dog lover himself, has generously offered to match donations destined for the Puppy Raisers up to \$1,000. Donations are provided to the organization which in turn provides funds as needed to the individual volunteers. Please see Mike Zaydel if you would like to see your donation doubled!

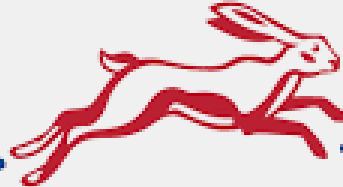

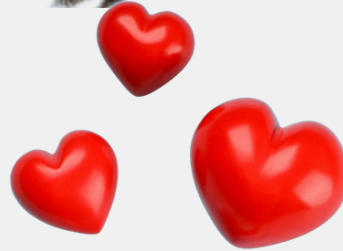

Every club has roles that keep the lights on. This one keeps the heart beating. The Service and Awards Chair is *the* person who makes sure no contribution goes unseen and no Lion goes uncelebrated. Some roles support the work. This one honors it.

Service and awards are not two functions that happen to share a title. **They are one. The person who tracks the data holds the context that makes every award nomination credible.** Separating them creates more work, more room for error, and less integrity in every recognition this club delivers.

SERVICE: YOU ARE THE RECORD

Every award and every number we report to Lions International starts here. You make sure the record is accurate and complete. Hours tell you who showed up, but impact tells you what their service actually accomplished. The Lion who changes lives in fewer hours deserves the same consideration as the Lion who logs the most time. This role captures both.

- ▶ **Member hour tracking.** Collect and verify service hours submitted by Lions across all activities.
- ▶ **Data accuracy.** You confirm what happened before it becomes the official club record.
- ▶ **Impact measurement.** Translate service hours into the real economic value our community receives.
- ▶ **LCI reporting.** Submit confirmed activities to Lions Clubs International on the club's behalf.
- ▶ **Club Excellence tracking.** Monitor award criteria and keep leadership informed throughout the year.
- ▶ **Event support.** Ensure data is captured at large events so no service goes unrecorded.
- ▶ **Roster integrity.** Keep member names and records consistent so everyone gets proper credit.

AWARDS: YOU TELL THE STORY

This is where the data becomes something a person carries with them. You are the one who champions each Lion's story.

- ▶ **Lion of the Quarter.** Each quarter: review nominees, run the member ballot, and present the award. Four times a year, you make someone's day.
- ▶ **District award nominations.** Write and submit the Gold Spur, Silver Spur, and Harry Reasonover packages to District 2-S3. Well-written nominations win.
- ▶ **Certificates and materials.** Design and produce the recognition pieces that make every award feel official. Templates and tools are already in place.
- ▶ **Award archives.** Maintain the nomination history so every future chair builds on a stronger foundation than the one before.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Comfort with details and deadlines. Clear, thoughtful writing. A genuine interest in making sure people get the recognition they deserve. **You do not need to be a tech expert.** You need to be organized and care about the people you serve.

Time commitment: Varies month to month, with a heavier lift during district award season (February through May). A full transition with the outgoing chair is available and encouraged.

WHAT YOU WILL GET

The satisfaction of knowing your work is the reason people feel seen. A front-row seat to everything this club does. Real skills in data stewardship, persuasive writing, and organizational leadership that transfer anywhere you go.

* *Additional recognition opportunities may be available, including the President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA), a congressional honor for which the club holds certifying organization status.*

** *The club has previously received the Kindness Matters Service Award (KMSA), given to approximately 30 clubs worldwide annually. Next eligibility: July 1, 2026. Club nomination due to the district by **September 1, 2026.***

Meal Coordinator This Lion coordinates the hosting calendar for the year ensuring each meeting is covered by a host. Normally each host covers the two meetings per month. The hosts make the arrangements for ordering and picking up the meals. The coordinator uses a software app that manages the notifications and reservations for each meal and interfaces with our website. The coordinator notifies the host of the number of reservations for each meal. The coordinator also monitors and orders meal supplies, assists with meal set up and that there is help for cleaning up after the meal. He or she stores the supplies after each meal.

4th of July Parade-The first event of the new fiscal year is our traditional participation in this parade...our smoker is pulled down Dawn Drive, patriotically decorated and bedecked with Lions tossing candy to the gathered crowd. Coordination between a driver for the truck towing the smoker, the smoker, purchase of candy, decorations and the means and people to do the decorating is what is required.
