



#### VISION SCREENING CONTINUES

Our team of Lions Mike Beal, Don Johndrow, Pat and Ted Rosen, Ken Johnston, Mike Zaydel, Anita Burke and Pete Pfile continue racking up growing numbers of screenings in area schools. This effort helps prevent permanent vision damage in children when amblyopia (lazy eye) can be detected and treated before the age of eight as well as identifying other vision irregularities that can be corrected with eyeglasses. In October different team members visited three schools in the early morning hours and screened over 1000 children.
