

CONSTITUTIONAL CARRY



Our August 17 meeting taught us a great deal about the upcoming enactment of HR 1927, better known as "Constitutional Carry". Sergeant Troy Schofield of the Lago Vista Police Department, explained how the new law changes existing law and what DOESN'T change. As of September 1, citizens of Texas will be empowered by State law to carry a firearm, in full view or concealed, as long as doing so complies with all restrictions and limitations already imposed on the carrying of a firearm without the need of a license. He emphasized that all other existing regulations remain in place and that all firearms being carried MUST BE HOLSTERED and may not be "brandished." Many of our members asked important questions and Sergeant Schofield was well prepared and eager to respond to all. Thank you for informing us, Sergeant Schofield!
